**Marymount T-shirts and P.E. shorts:** Lower School Office  
**Shoes and socks** may be purchased anywhere.

**Girls:** White uniform blouse with piping (white cotton turtleneck in cold weather), or Marymount navy t-shirt  
Marymount plaid shift or skort  
Navy blue P.E. shorts or bike shorts (worn under plaid shift)  
Navy blue pleated or flat front uniform pants may be worn during cold weather  
Navy blue or white socks  
Closed shoes suitable for movement activities

**Boys:** Uniform Cardinal red polo shirt with Marymount logo (white cotton turtleneck in cold weather) or Marymount navy t-shirt

Navy blue or white socks  
Closed shoes suitable for movement activities
