MARYMOUNT DRESS CODE Kindergarten - Grade 6

We believe that the way students dress at school is a reflection of our school. We list below items that currently comply with our desire to have neat, modestly attired, and well-groomed students. Earrings for boys and hair coloring are not allowed. Fashion accessories are discouraged. Oversized shorts, shirts, or sweatshirts may not be worn. Shirts are to be tucked in for assemblies. **Names should be marked on all items of clothing.** Questions about whether or not something constitutes appropriate dress should be brought to the Division Head.

Where to purchase the uniform: Jumpers, skirts, skorts, shirts, blouses, white cotton turtlenecks, Marymount uniform sweatshirts, fleece or micro fiber jackets, and navy blue uniform walk or bike shorts/slacks: Dennis Uniforms (818 887-5376), www.dennisuniform.com. **Shoes and socks**, may be purchased anywhere.

Marymount T-shirts and P.E. shorts: School Office

Uniform Exchange: Gently used uniforms may be donated to the school. The MPC organizes them for use. Inquire in the School Office, x.100.

Girls: K - 4: Marymount plaid jumper and white uniform blouse (white cotton turtleneck in cold weather)
Navy blue gym shorts or bike shorts (worn under uniform jumper)
Navy blue pleated or flat front uniform pants may be worn during cold weather

Girls: 5 - 6: Marymount plaid skirt or skort (required dress on liturgy and special assembly days)
Navy blue uniform twill or corduroy walk shorts/pants
Astro or CIMI Camp sweatshirt (optional)
Cardinal red or ash gray polo shirt with Marymount logo, or white cotton turtleneck

Gr. K - 6: Marymount navy blue or ash gray sweatshirt with logo (three styles available)
Navy blue or white socks
Closed shoes suitable for P.E.

Boys: K - 6: Navy blue uniform twill or corduroy walk shorts/pants (pants required on liturgy and special assembly days)
Uniform Cardinal red or ash gray polo shirt with Marymount logo (white cotton turtleneck in cold weather)
Marymount navy blue or ash gray sweatshirt with logo (three styles available)
Navy blue or white socks
Closed shoes suitable for P.E.

Boys: 5 - 6: Astro or CIMI Camp sweatshirt (optional)
Navy blue uniform twill or corduroy walk shorts/pants (pants required on liturgy and special assembly days)

Jackets: Navy blue fleece or micro fiber jackets, zip or pullover, with or without logo may be worn.

P.E. Uniform: Gr. 4 - 5: Boys and girls wear Marymount T-shirts and uniform shorts or P.E. shorts
Gr. 6: Boys and girls wear Marymount T-shirts and P.E. shorts

Bathing Suits: One piece, modest bathing suits for girls, to be worn in pool area only.

Undershirts: Boys may wear only white undershirts or Marymount T-shirts under their uniform shirts or Scout uniforms.

Hats: Hats may not be worn except outdoors, brim forward.

Free Dress Days: Students may wear conventional casual clothes. These days are announced in the *Marymount Messenger*.

MARYMOUNT DRESS CODE Grades 7 & 8

We believe the way students dress at school is a reflection of our program. We list below items that currently comply with our desire to have neat, modestly attired, and well-groomed students. Earrings for boys are not allowed. Haircoloring for boys and girls is not allowed. Oversized shorts, shirts, or sweatshirts may not be worn. Failure to comply with the Dress Code is a detention offense. **Names should be marked on all clothing.** Questions about appropriate dress should be brought to the Division Head.

Where to buy: You may purchase Polo style shirts, pants, shorts, sweatshirts, and fleece jackets at Dennis Uniform (818 887-5376, www.dennisuniform.com).

*Marymount T-shirt and P.E. shorts may be purchased in the Marymount Office. Other items may be purchased at Dennis Uniform www.dennisuniform.com or anywhere.

We require modest dress for free dress days and campus activities.

Shorts:	White, navy blue (not denim), black, tan, corduroy or twill <u>walk shorts</u> (no shorter than mid-thigh and no oversized shorts).
Pants:	White, navy blue (not denim), black, tan, twill, corduroy, or cotton pants; no “cargo” style pants (pants required for boys on liturgy and special assembly days).
Skirts:	White, navy blue (not denim), black, or tan skirts of modest length; no slits or fringe (skirts required for girls on liturgy and special assembly days).
Shirts:	White, navy blue, red, cardinal red, ash grey, or black Polo style shirts with collar. These can be plain, or have the Marymount logo or another logo (logo no larger than a credit card). Layered shirts must be in the dress code colors. Shirts must be tucked in on liturgy/special assembly days.
Turtlenecks:	White, navy blue, red, or black
Socks:	White, navy blue, or black
Shoes:	Closed shoes, securely laced, suitable for P.E. activities
Sweatshirts:	Navy blue or ash gray sweatshirt (school logo optional; three styles available). CIMI sweatshirts may be worn.
Jackets:	Students may wear any type of jacket to school but not in the classroom. Navy fleece jackets, zip up or pullover, are available for purchase through Dennis Uniform
Hats:	May not be worn except outdoors, brim forward

P.E. UNIFORM

Shorts:	*Marymount P.E. shorts
T-shirt:	*Marymount navy blue t-shirt
Sweatshirts/ Sweatpants:	Marymount navy blue or ash gray sweatshirt (school logo optional) and navy blue or ash gray sweatpants
Socks:	White, navy blue, or black
Bathing suits:	One piece, modest, to be worn in pool area only
After School Sports Uniform:	Acceptable in P.E. on the days of games only
